### Show and Tell

The September meeting had a good showing for show-n-tell.



## September Meeting Demonstration

Jim Dupler demonstrated how to make a "star in cube", which he learned at a demo by David Springett. He had examples in walnut and maple. It needs to be very dry. They start out as a 2 1/4" (very) square block, sanding the faces smooth before turning starts. Jim had to manufacture a set of

jaws to hold the cube out of some 2 1/4" thick hardwood and a band clamp for pressure. He also had to create his own set of specialty turning tools and a wide flat tool rest. As each face is turned, part of the star is made. Then a 3/16" thick plug is placed in the hole and around the new star tip. Hot melt glue can be used to

help the plugs fit more snugly. This supports the star while turning the other faces. This process continues for each re-chucking of the cube. Jim said it was best to turn the two end grain faces first. Thanks Jim!

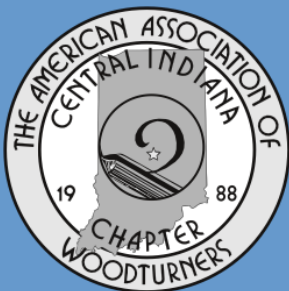

From US-421 and SR-32, go SOUTH on US-421. (2.0 miles)  
Turn RIGHT onto W 156TH ST / COUNTY ROAD 200 S. (0.9 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto COUNTY ROAD 950 E / PLEASANT VIEW RD / N 68TH RD.  
Continue to follow N 68TH RD. (3.4 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto ZIONSVILLE RD. / ZIONSVILLE-WHITESTOWN RD. (< 0.1 miles)

**Directions from the south:**

From I-465 and MICHIGAN Rd. (becomes US-421), go NORTH (2.8 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto CR-550 S / TEMPLIN RD. (0.6 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto S 1100 E / WILLOW RD. (0.1 miles)  
Turn RIGHT onto TEMPLE AVE. (0.3 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto TURKEY FOOT RD. (0.1 miles)  
Turn SHARP RIGHT onto ZIONSVILLE RD. / ZIONSVILLE-WHITESTOWN RD. (0.9 miles)
