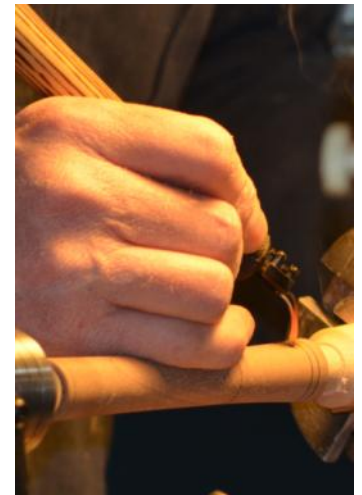

Tim Kennedy showed off his art work made with his homemade pyrography set.

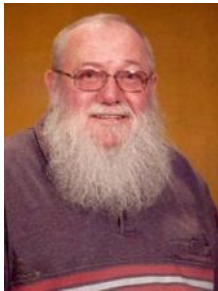


John Harris brought in a very nice myrtle bowl. Unfortunately I do not have a picture of Mr. Harris for the newsletter.

Turn LEFT onto COUNTY ROAD 950 E / PLEASANT VIEW RD / N 68TH RD. Continue to follow N 68TH RD. (3.4 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto ZIONSVILLE RD. / ZIONSVILLE-WHITESTOWN RD. (<0.1 miles)

**Directions from the south:**

From I-465 and MICHIGAN RD. (becomes US-421), go NORTH (2.8 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto CR-550 S / TEMPLIN RD. (0.6 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto S 1100 E / WILLOW RD. (0.1 miles)  
Turn RIGHT onto TEMPLE AVE. (0.3 miles)  
Turn LEFT onto TURKEY FOOT RD. (0.1 miles)  
Turn SHARP RIGHT onto ZIONSVILLE RD.
