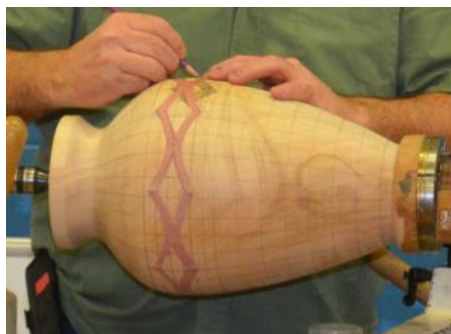

It is always a nice feeling working with tools you make yourself.

This month Tim Kennedy will demonstrate how to make your own pyrography hand piece and burning tips. He will demonstrate how to turn the handle on the lathe. Then he will embellish the handle by burning a texture into the grip area. He will assemble all the electrical parts and then put it all together with a little bit of epoxy. The finished hand piece could be plugged into a base unit you bought, or if you are more adventurous you could also make your own power supply.

**Directions from the north:**

From US-421 and SR-32, go SOUTH on US-421. (2.0 miles)

Turn RIGHT on W 156TH ST / COUNTY ROAD 200 S. (p.9 miles)

Turn LEFT onto COUNTY ROAD 950 E / PLEASANT VIEW RD / N 68TH RD. Continue to follow N 68TH RD. (3.4 miles)

Turn LEFT onto ZIONSVILLE RD. / ZIONSVILLE-WHITESTOWN RD. (<0.1 miles)

**Directions from the south:**

From I-465 and MICHIGAN RD. (becomes US-421), go NORTH (2.8 miles)

Turn LEFT onto CR-550 S / TEMPLIN RD. (0.6 miles)

Turn LEFT onto S 1100 E / WILLOW RD. (0.1 miles)

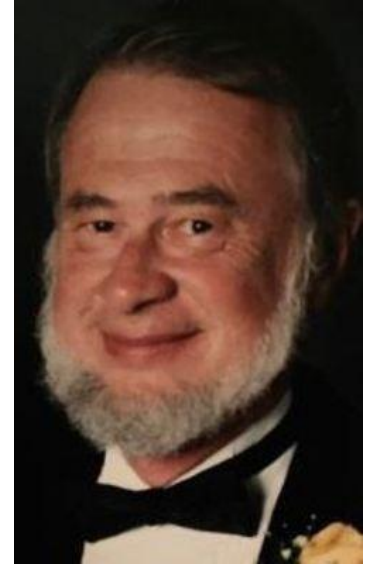
Turn RIGHT onto TEMPLE AVE. (0.3 miles)

Turn LEFT onto TURKEY FOOT RD. (0.1 miles)

Turn SHARP RIGHT onto ZIONSVILLE RD.
